Richard Moore began his professional career in resource protection and boating law enforcement in January 1990. He has worked through the ranks as a law enforcement officer, regional training officer, assistant boating safety coordinator, and watch commander. He has served as boating law administrator and manager of Florida's Boating Safety Program since 2002.
