Alfonso became the Marine Enforcement Chief at TPWD in November 2003. He became a Texas Game Warden in 1985 and spent eight years as a boating safety officer on busy Lake Travis near Austin. Prior service included five years as an Instructor at the Game Warden Training Academy and six years as Asst. Chief of Marine Enforcement in Austin. At his present post Alfonso serves as the Boating Law Administrator for the State of Texas.

His responsibilities include reviewing proposed boating legislation; dealing with boating constituents and industry officials; acquiring federal funding for state boating programs; and analyzing boating accident reports to spearhead the Agency's efforts to improve boating safety on Texas' public waterways.

Campos grew up on a 7,800-acre ranch in Central Texas and graduated from Tarleton State University in Stephenville, TX. He has chaired the Law Enforcement Committee of the National Association of State Boating Law Administrators; has served as president of the Southern States Boating Law Administrators and was appointed by Homeland Security Secretary Michael Chertoff to the National Boating Safety Advisory Council in 2008.

Campos and his wife Connie have three children and live south of Austin in Maxwell, TX.
